Items that we do **NOT** accept:

- Broken items
- Entertainment centers
- Guns, explosives, ammunition and mace
- Hazardous materials

- Infant and child car seats
- Large appliances
- Large electrical exercise equipment
- Magazines (we accept National Geographic)
- Mattresses and box springs
- Opened paint, oil-based liquids and flammable items
- Pianos
- Printers
- Scrap building materials
- TV's of any kind
- Used or open medical supplies
