Items that we do not accept:

- Hazardous Materials
- Guns, Explosives, Ammunition, and Mace
- Opened Paint, Oil-Based Liquids and Flammable Items
- Tube TV's (we accept Flat Screen TVs)
- Damaged/Soiled Mattresses
- Scrap building materials
- Infant & child car seats
- Large, nonworking, untestable appliances
- Used or open medical supplies
- Magazines (we accept National Geographic)
- Broken items
