What is T-N-R

TNR is the process of trapping feral cats in the colony they live, altering (and vaccinating) them and returning them to the colony.

If I don't want the cat back, can you bring him somewhere?

Unfortunately, there are far more feral cats than there are resources for these animals. At this time feral cats must be returned to their homes/colonies.

What can I do about feral cats harassing my cats and using my garden as their bathroom?

Get them fixed! Spaying and neutering stops fighting, roaming and other unwanted behaviors. To keep cats out of your yard, visit: www.cat-repellant.info for humane solutions to keep feral cats away from you home and pets.
