## I understand the following terms & conditions:

- ◆ For the safety of our staff, we require all feral cats to be brought in a trap
- The cat must be at least 4 months old
- The cat will have its left ear "tipped/notched" and receive a rabies vaccination
- ◆ I will return the cat to the location from which it was taken
- I understand that any animal faces a risk when put under anesthesia
- I agree to return to pick up the cat at the specified time and adhere to the discharge instructions
- If the cat is not picked up within the time given, there is a possibility of euthanasia that will be decided by LPCHS staff
- Any cat deemed by the veterinarian to be severely ill or injured will be humanely euthanized
